To borrow a book:

You need a library card.

Please write your name, birth date, address, telephone number, school name, grade, and class on the application form.

(Please come to the library to fill out the form.)

You can get a library card if you live in Kobe or one of its neighboring cities such as Akashi, or if you attend a school in Kobe.

Library cards can be used at any Kobe City Library.

Library cards are good for 10 years.

Please be careful not to lose it.



If you find a book you want to borrow: Please bring the book and your library card to the counter.

Books can be borrowed for 2 weeks and you can borrow up to 10 books at a time.

You will need a password to use this service. Please go to the library counter with an adult to register.


Children's Reading Week Events
