Outside of home and school, we are also creating cozy spaces in the community, where you can spend time with other people, eat meals together, study, and just be yourself.


## **Speak Up, and Be Heard!**

## **Protecting Every Child**

We are working to make Kobe into a place where everyone feels safe to try new things, and share your thoughts. It's important to learn about your body, your feelings, and how special life is. You also have rights— and we want to help you understand how to use them.

Adults will protect you from people who hurt you or are mean to you. If someone tries to hurt you, or if you are in trouble, find an adult and tell them what happened.



# A Safe Place Where Everyone Can Grow

If you're feeling worried or something is bothering you, you can always talk to an adult at school or at your community children's center. If it's hard to say things out loud directly to someone, you can write a letter, call, or send a message online whenever you need to.

If you're not living with your family, we'll make sure you have a safe and happy place to live, where you can feel comfortable and cared for.

Everyone grows up in their own unique way. We're also here to support kids who may grow at a different pace, or have special needs, so they can join in with everyone and have fun in a way that feels right for them.

If you don't speak Japanese, or if your family has money problems, or if you help take care of your family, we'll make sure you still have chances to learn and play just like everyone else.

## Support for Your Family

We're here to help your family with things like taking care of babies, paying for hospital visits, school meals, and commuting costs to go to senior high school. As you grow, we'll support your family so you can focus on what matters.

We also work with companies to make sure your parents or guardians can spend more quality time with you.
