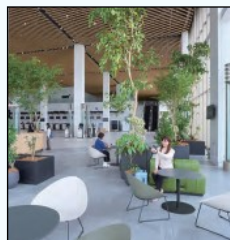

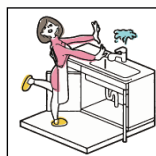

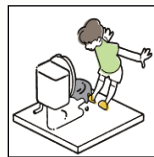


## For Plumbing Issues, Contact the Water Repair Reception Center

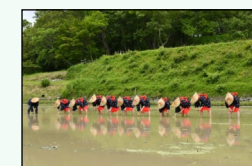
