## Online Moving Procedures & Sunday Service Counter

From March through April, moving-related procedures tend to be very busy. To save time, you can take advantage of online procedures or visit your local Sunday service counter.

If you are moving outside of Kobe City, you must submit a moving-out notification to your local Ward Office within 14 days before or after your move. With a MyNumber Card, you can apply online using your smartphone or computer. You can also download the moving-out notification form from Kobe City's website, and submit it by mail.

## Fines for Bicycle Traffic Violations

Beginning April 1, fines will be issued for bicycle-related traffic violations. These rules apply to everyone aged 16 and older, including high school students. Please follow traffic laws and ride your bicycle safely.



- Do not use a smartphone while cycling.



**Penalty:** 12,000 yen

- Remember to stop at a stop sign, use your bike lights, and do NOT cycle while using earphones.



**Penalty:** 5,000 yen

- Do not disobey traffic signals and do not cycle outside designated areas.



**Penalty:** 6,000 yen

## Mt. Maya Moude Festival



The Maya Moude Festival, part of the Mt. Maya Spring Opening, is a revived celebration of Maya a traditional horse-protection and purification ritual once performed at Mayasan Tenjoji Temple long before the Edo period.

In this event, horses from the Rokkosan Ranch receive a purification blessing at Tenjoji, then join a parade to Kikuseidai Observatory Deck, accompanied by shrine maidens and monks.
