Tackling Rising Prices

Food Support Kobe

Residents in all wards across Kobe City who are heavily affected by inflation and rising costs are eligible to receive five days' worth of food and daily essentials, for free, in spring and in autumn.

To participate, **please bring:** Documents with proof of address (ex. MyNumber Card, driver's license, mail addressed to you with your address written on it)



Childrearing Support

School lunches at municipal elementary schools will be free of cost; the cost of school lunches at municipal junior high schools will be reduced.

Fire Warning and Fire Advisory Alerts Under New Standards Starting April 1

To strengthen fire prevention efforts, warnings and advisories for fire-related disasters will now be issued under new standards.

When a fire warning is issued, the use of fire outdoors will be restricted, including activities such as open burning, fireworks, and smoking near flammable materials. Violations may result in penalties such as fines.

Examples of restricted activities:

- Bonfires / open burning
- Fireworks
- Smoking near flammable materials
