Use the free *mymizu* app to find refill locations in the city!







Get a Rubella Antibody Test & Vaccination!

If an adult contracts rubella, they have a much higher chance of developing serious symptoms. They can even spread the virus to others in the week before symptoms start to appear. If a pregnant woman contracts the disease during the early stages of her pregnancy, the virus can lead to eye, ear, and heart problems when the child is born.

All male residents of Kobe who were born between April 2, 1962—April 1, 1979 will have received a voucher for free antibody testing in the mail. If the test reveals that you have no rubella antibodies, you can receive a rubella vaccination for free.

If you lost or did not receive a voucher in the mail , you can have it reissued.



Get a Taxi Voucher for Nursing and Expectant Mothers

When you submit your Pregnancy Notification at the ward office, you can receive a Taxi Voucher. (Valid for up to 5,000 yen)

If you already submitted your Pregnancy Notification between January 4 and June 30, 2021, you should receive a postcard in the mail that you can exchange at the ward office for the voucher.
