The BA.1 Omicron variant COVID-19 vaccine is currently being administered, but it will be changed to one that targets the BA.4-5 Omicron variant.

About BA. I and BA.4-5

Regardless of whether you are vaccinated with the versions that target BA.1 or BA.4-5, they should both be more effective against the Omicron variant of COVID-19. They should also help prevent worsening of symptoms, infectiousness, and onset of symptoms.

Preconception Care

Preconception care refers to the health and daily life interventions taken by both parents in anticipation of pregnancy.

A strong awareness of personal health by both parents is connected to a safe pregnancy and baby's health. It is important to apply good diet, exercise, and sleeping habits to one's daily routine. Try to make these changes long before a future pregnancy.

Kobe Phosphorus REmoval Project

As one of the three major nutrients in fertilizer, phosphorus is an essential agricultural resource. However, the majority of phosphorus in Japan is imported, and prices are soaring due to export restrictions in the producing countries.

In order to help stabilize the country's agricultural industry in an initiative towards renewable agriculture, Kobe City is working to collect phosphorus from sewage and use it in Kobe Harvest fertilizer. This initiative is called the "Kobe Saisei Rin" project. (Kobe Phosphorus REmoval Project)

In order to promote this Sustainable Development Goal, Kobe Harvest will be available for home garden use from mid-December.
