In 1923, Kobe became the birthplace of jazz in Japan when the first jazz performance by a professional band was conducted in the city's former foreign commercial district, and this year marks the 100th anniversary of jazz in Japan. Kobe's jazz history

1923: A professional band plays jazz in Japan for the first time at the Oriental Hotel in Kyukyoryuchi (the former foreign commercial district)




1953: JAVA (presently the oldest jazz café in Japan) opens for business (Chuo Ward)



1971: The first high school jazz band in Japan is formed at Kobe Murano Technical High School

1982: Kobe Jazz Street is held for the first time



1993: The Japan Student Jazz Festival changes venues from Osaka to Kobe

2014: April 4 is registered as "Kobe Jazz Day" by the Japan Anniversary Association

2016: The Kobe Youth Jazz Orchestra is formed by junior and high school senior students



2023: 100 years since a professional band first played jazz in Japan

COVID-19 information

Mask-wearing recommendations have changed

From March 13, the decision to wear a mask is left to the individual, regardless of indoors or outdoors. Please do not force others to wear a mask. However, you should wear a mask if you have COVID-19-like symptoms, live with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or are visiting/working at a hospital or elderly care facility.

COVID-19 vaccination schedule for 2023 (for ages 5 & up)

For 3rd-dose & later vaccinations:

① Seniors aged 65 & up, or people with underlying health conditions: Can be vaccinated twice a year, in spring-summer (May - Aug.) and autumn-winter (Sep. - Dec.). We will make an announcement about when vaccination vouchers will be mailed out and other details at a later date.

② All others aged 5 & up: Can be vaccinated once a year, in autumn-winter (Sep. - Dec.).

For 1st- & 2nd-dose vaccinations:

Vaccinations are still available now.

Syphilis cases have rapidly risen

Syphilis cases rapidly increased in 2022 all over Japan, and in Kobe the cases have increased about 17-fold within the past 10 years. Most of the cases have occurred among men aged 20-50, and women in their 20s. If you are not experiencing symptoms but are worried you may have caught syphilis, you can get tested anonymously for free through the city's public health centers. If you do have symptoms, please see a doctor.

Working towards the bright future of Kobe

Part of Kobe City's budget for the 2023 fiscal year is going towards a number of initiatives, including **these 3 projects**.

① The new Community Engagement and Development Bureau

There are many people who want to do more to help their local communities, so this new bureau was created to help make it easier for NPOs and other groups to become involved in city policies.



② Expansion of the Children's Medical Expense Subsidy!

Children up to senior high school age will be eligible for subsidization of outpatient medical fees.

*1 Per hospital/clinic or pharmacy

*2 Hospitalization is free up to SHS age

③ Preparing Kobe Airport for international flights!

To start with, we will expand the airport apron (plane parking area) and construct a sub-terminal by 2025!

We will also make transportation between the airport and Sannomiya/Shin-Kobe more convenient, and draw more tourists by making the city more attractive!



Ride cross bikes through the Kande-Yamada Cycling Road

Running through the rural woodlands of Kobe's Kita and Nishi Wards, the Kande-Yamada Cycling Road lets you experience the beauty of nature. In the spring, you can cycle through paths lined with cherry blossom trees. Even if you don't own a bicycle, you can easily enjoy this cycling experience with a rental cross bike.

There are 4 rental/return locations along the cycling road, including a café right by the train station. Electric-assisted bicycles are also available at some locations. Won't you come feel the spring breeze and get your fill of nature?

By your side from pregnancy to birth to childrearing

Under the Support Program for Expecting, New & Childrearing Families, we offer emotional and financial support during every step of a family's journey from pregnancy to child-rearing.

If you ever need to seek advice about birth or childcare during/after pregnancy, you can talk to the Health and Welfare Division of your local ward office at any time. You can also receive a subsidy to help offset the personal costs of baby products and childcare services.

About the subsidy

Eligibility: On or after April 1, 2022, either:

- ① Expecting mother filed a Notification of Pregnancy, OR
- ② A newborn was born (and is in the care of a caretaker)

Amount: 50,000 yen at the time the notification was filed, then 50,000 yen per child after birth

How to apply: e-KOBE smart application system

● **Notification/birth as of February 28, 2023:**

Application information will be sent from late March via simplified registered mail

● **Notification/birth on or after March 1, 2023:**

In principle, a staff member will discuss this when you file the pregnancy notification, and application information will be provided during the newborn visit
