





# Nenebashi

The vermilion Nenebashi, a striking landmark at the entrance of Arima Onsen, offers a breathtaking view of the cherry blossoms lining Arima river below. This bridge is called "Nenebashi" because it is said that Nene, the wife of Toyotomi Hideyoshi (one of the most famous samurais), crossed it when she visited Arima Onsen. The beautiful contrast between the bridge and the cherry blossoms is a must-see.



# Togagawa Park

## Himeji Castle

Himeji Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its stunning white exterior, is a must-visit destination. Admire the striking contrast of the white castle walls and the vibrant pink cherry blossoms.

▶ Access from Kobe city centre :

Please take JR line from Sannomiya station to Himeji station (The super rapid train ride takes 37 minutes.)

## Shukugawa park

Shukugawa Park is a beautiful urban oasis featuring approximately 1,000 cherry blossom trees lining both sides of the river. During the blooming period, the park is filled with visitors enjoying cherry blossom viewing.

▶ Access from Kobe city centre :

Please take Hankyu Railway from Kobe-Sannomiya station to Shukugawa station (The express train ride takes 11 minutes.)

## Ono Sakura Tsuzumi Corridor

Ono Sakura Tsuzumi Corridor is famous for its 4km-long cherry blossom avenue which is one of Western Japan's longest. Thanks to the five different species of cherry blossom trees planted and their differing blooming times, visitors can enjoy cherry blossoms for a long period. If you want to see beautiful cherry blossoms against a clear blue sky in typical Japanese countryside, be sure to add this place to your bucket list!

▶ Access from Kobe city centre :


Please take Hankyu Railway from Kobe-Sannomiya station to Shinkaichi station, and then transfer to Kobe Electric Railway (Ao Line) and get off at Ono station (The entire trip takes about 70 minutes.)
