2026 Kobe Turning Twenty Ceremony Information

Coming of Age Day is a Japanese holiday on the second Monday in January that celebrates the entry into adulthood for people who have recently turned 20 years old. Kobe City holds a ceremony every year to mark this occasion for all Kobe residents who turned 20 during the fiscal year. As the official age of adulthood in Japan was recently changed to 18 years of age, this ceremony is now called the "Turning Twenty Ceremony" (*Hatachi wo Iwau Kai*).

The invitation to attend the ceremony is extended to all Kobe residents, regardless of citizenship, who were born between April 2, 2005 and April 1, 2006. As this is a non-denominational, non-political ceremony, we look forward to welcoming all eligible residents who wish to participate.
